The first vintage of Helix Cabernet Sauvignon was in 2005. Primarily sourced from Phinny Hill and Stone Tree Vineyards, year after year our Cabernets have bright acidity and lively dark fruit notes. Highlights of past accolades includes 90 points & “Cellar Selection, *Wine Enthusiast* on the 2010 vintage as well as included in the *Seattle Times* “Top 50 Wines.” The 2012 vintage also received 91 points from *Wine Spectator*.

2014 HELIX CABERNET SAUVIGNON



The inviting aromas proffered by this very warm vintage 2014 Phinny Hill Cabernet Sauvignon are true to the varietal. Dark cherry, plum and currant are interlaced with a hint of herb as well as soft, sweet notes of brown oak spice.

Its palate possesses a pleasing body weight with a fine-grained tannin structure and relaxed acidity. Toasted oak, with hints of cedar, escorts black fruit flavors dominated by currant and cherry from start to finish.
