


# Helix 2013 Phinny Hill Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon



## DESCRIPTION

“There is no doubt this is the most relaxed Cabernet Sauvignon that we have ever produced. Fruit forward with well-worn khakis. Lofty aromatics are full of cherry and red plum, swirling with whiffs of sweet oak spice followed by a paper-thin slice of steak tartar. With its very soft tannins, the wine enters the mouth ever so gently yet with lively acidity that elevates a delightful blend of Chelan cherry, plum, currant and a hint of marionberry tagged with a beautiful lingering finish of bright cherry accompanied by brown baking spices and light oak.
