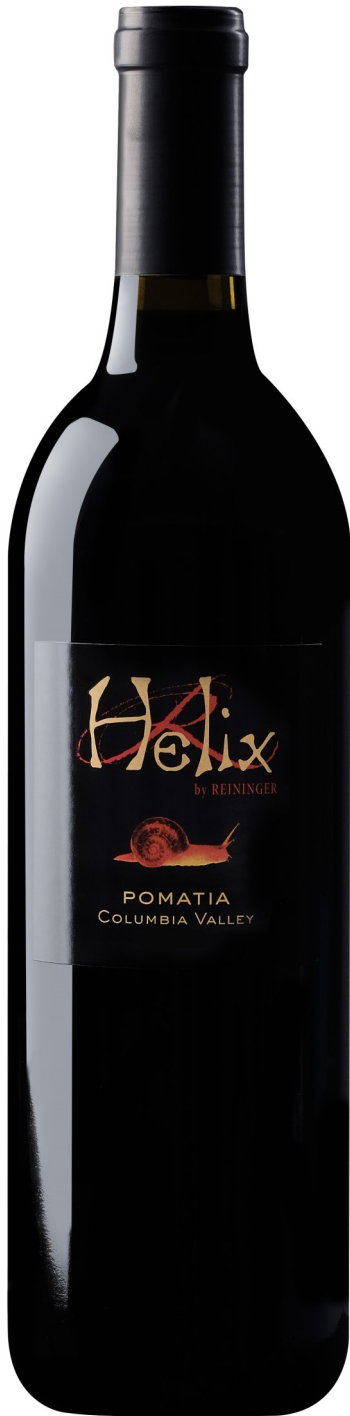


# Helix 2015 Pomatia

### DESCRIPTION

“2015 was another heated year on the heels of two previous hot vintages. Somewhat cooler fall temperatures provided a bit of reprieve, allowing for deep rich fruit development. Pomatia possesses a purple-dark garnet color with a fragrant, violet, light floral incense, ripe-dark fruit, bramble berries, and jammy nose. It has a delightful, soft palate, balanced acidity, a touch of fleshiness and a nucleus of black fruits, sour black cherry, blueberry, blackberry, lingering black raspberry jam and a very fine hint of white pepper. ### STORY OF POMATIA

Pomatia is our flagship wine under the Helix brand. This Bordeaux-Syrah blend has been comprised of some of the best fruit the Columbia Valley has to offer since its first vintage in 2002. Today, Pomatia is one of our most widely distributed wines. The name Helix Pomatia derives from a Burgundian snail, whose genus species name is Helix Pomatia, that is commonly served as escargot. As a winery that focuses on French grape varieties, we thought the Helix Pomatia snail would be a perfect mascot for the Helix brand. After all, a snail's pace can be a good thing – especially in winemaking and wine appreciation. Highlights of past accolades include:
