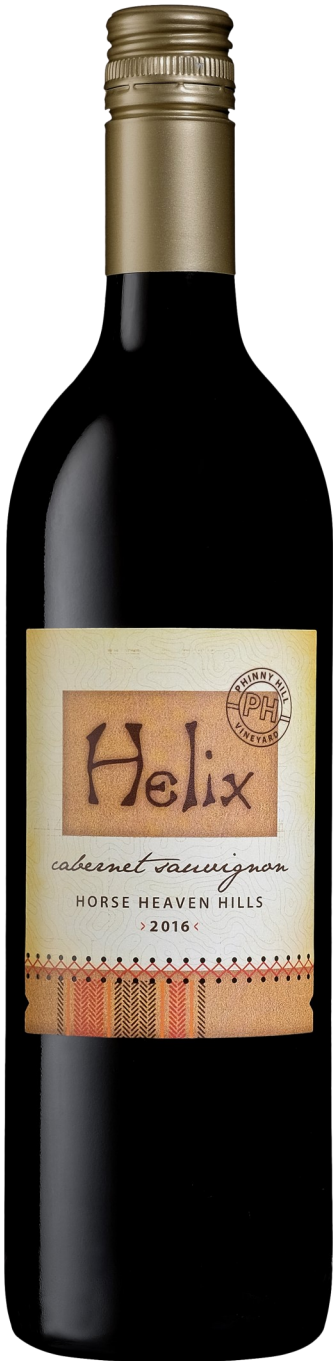


2016 helix cabernet sauvignon

Phinny Hill Vineyard, Horse Heaven Hills



description

2016 began with an early, hot, dry spring that eventually led to an early harvest. September cooled off some but, had intermittent blasts of heat.

Scents, dominated by macerated black cherry and black currant, blended with hints of baking spices and medium roast coffee beans, grace the nose. A very soft palate with ample acidity carries flavors of dark cherry and plum with touches of currant, blackberry and fig melded with wood toast, followed by a lengthy finish of bright, dark fruit. ~Chuck Reininger, Winemaker

Phinny Hill We were one of the first brands to source fruit from Phinny Hill and we're the only ones who've used our 5-acre block. Our Helix Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah flourish on this stellar site in Alderdale, WA. Our vines are east-facing, get plenty of heat and achieve good hang time. Phinny Hill Vineyard was planted under grower Dick Beightol's care on the western side of the Horse Heaven Hills AVA. Overlooking Champoux Vineyard and the Columbia River at an elevation of 750 feet, Phinny Hill is one of the most picturesque spots in the Horse Heaven Hills.

cooperage

100% French oak (18% new) Our Cabernet features less oak than most to achieve a more complex, sophisticated wine with elegant fruit and tannin structure that let the vineyard shine through.
